# Outcomes and Impact

Saved student seat time data was utilized at the **state level** to inform budget deliberations.

Better relationships with schools which allowed for more **universal screenings at SBHCs.**

Behavioral health and medical providers have ongoing communication with patients regarding **attendance and academics.**

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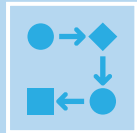
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# Challenges & Barriers

Regular touchpoints with Azara to align ingestion process



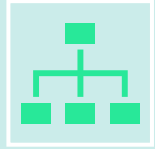
Prioritized efficient cross-team scheduling to maximize joint working sessions

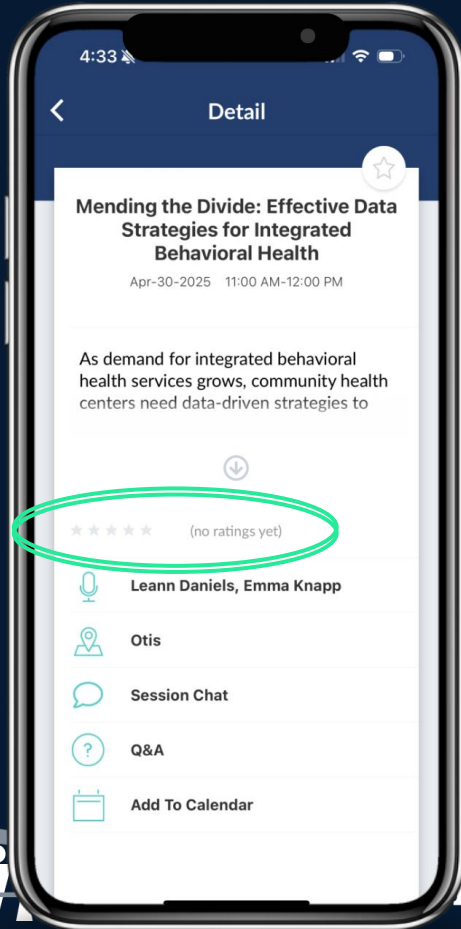

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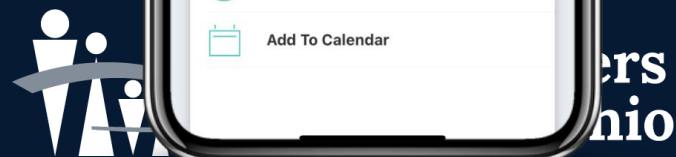
