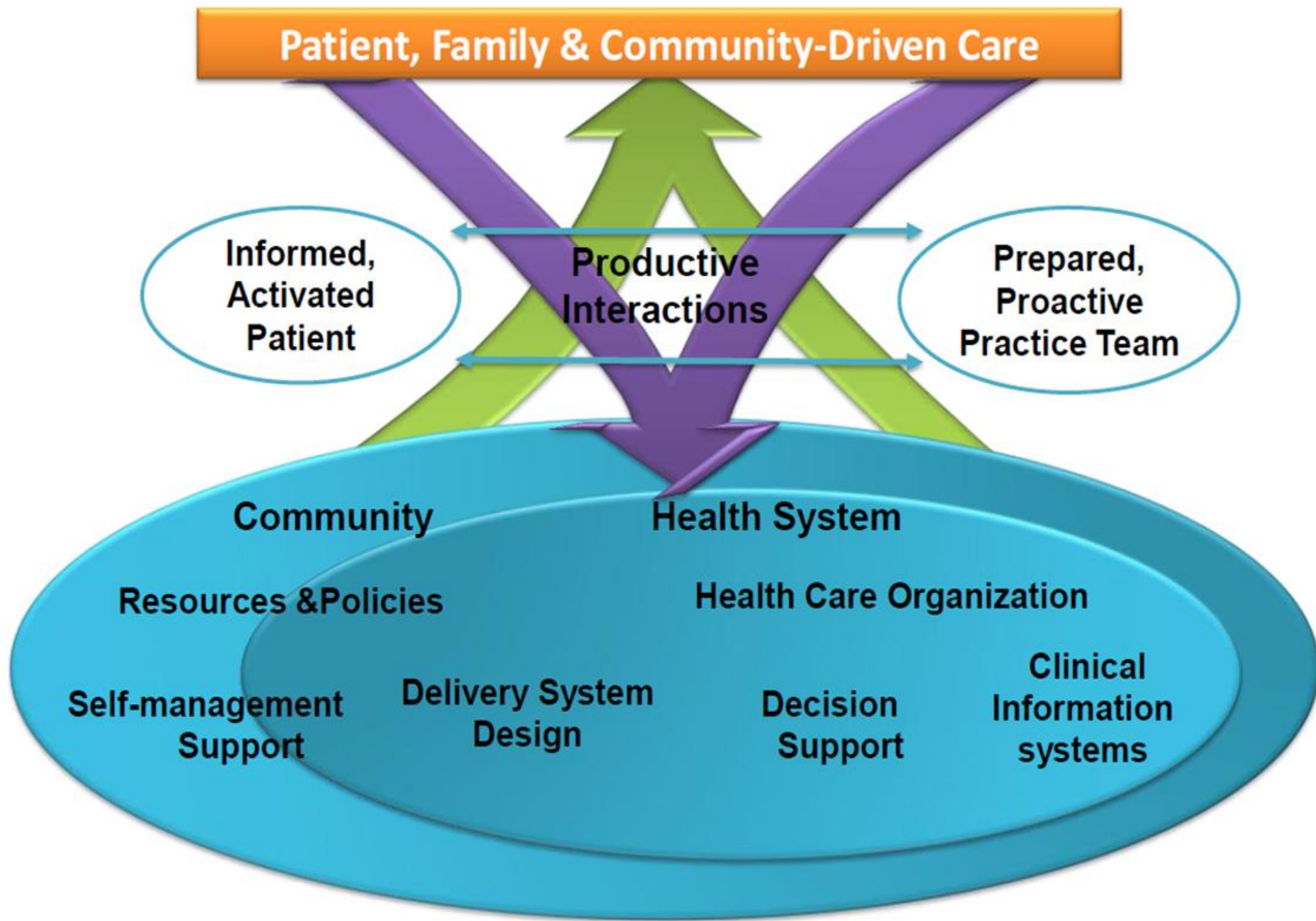

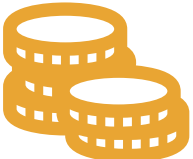

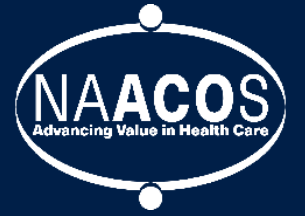

NAACOS offers a variety of educational webinars, conferences, and other events to help value-based care entities stay up-to-date on the latest developments in the field and learn from experts and peers.

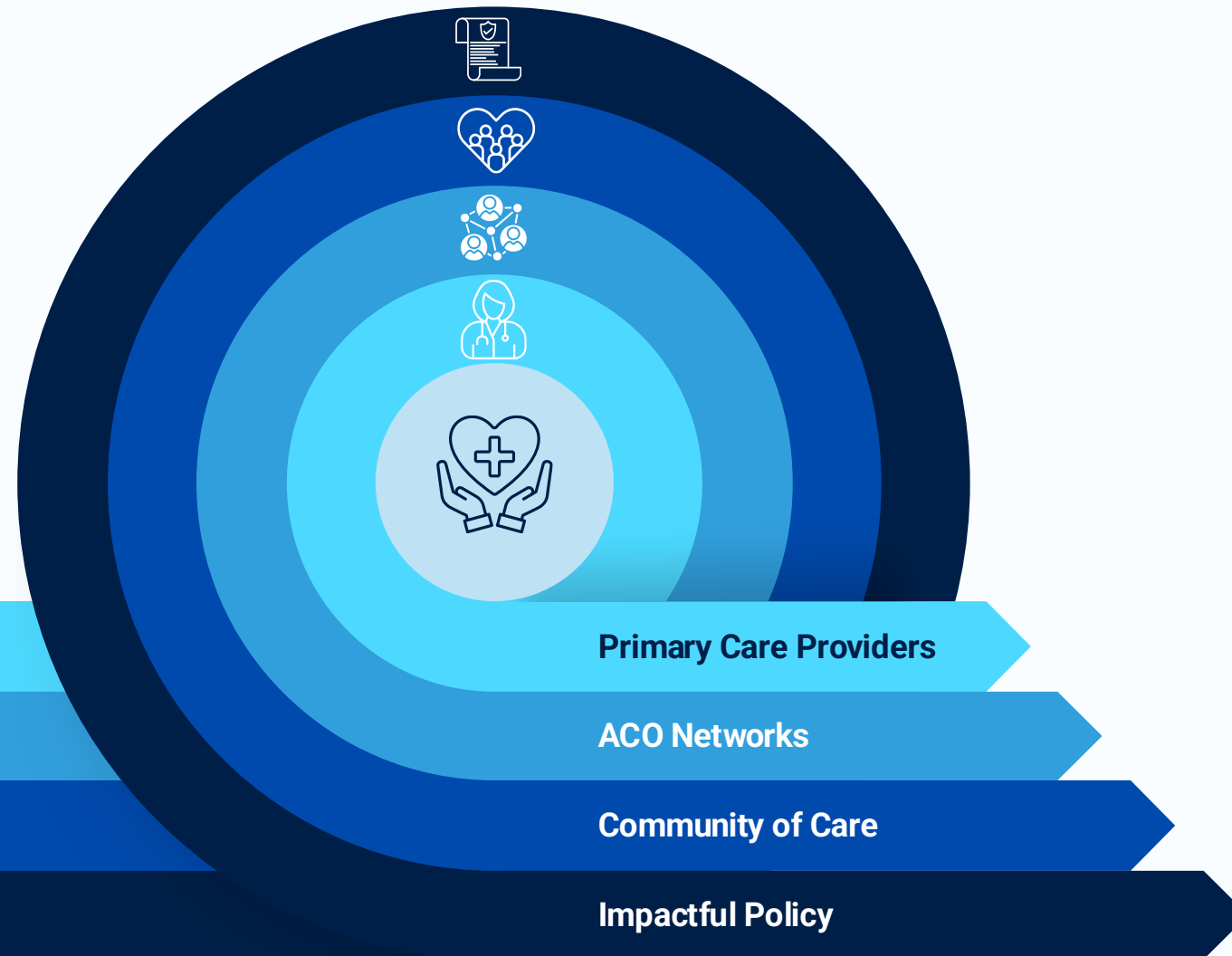


ADVOCACY
