TRACKING & IMPROVING CARE FOR PREGNANT AND POSTPARTUM PATIENTS

Azara DRVS Maternal Care solutions enable practices to identify and report on pregnant and postpartum patients, helping to drive improved birth outcomes for mother and baby. With this module, practices can easily view all pregnant and perinatal patients and evaluate completeness of care, including support to capture trimester of entry and birthweight for UDS reporting. There are nearly 100 data points available within the Obstetrics (OB) Module in categories ranging from demographics to birth details, grouped by pregnancy episode with detailed test dates and results and accompanying appointment information. This module now expands across the Azara product suite – including PVP Alerts, the Prenatal Passport, and the Maternal Care Management report in DRVS as well as Azara Patient Outreach campaigns, documents in the EHR Plug-In, and Azara Care Connect Dynamic Cohorts.

The OB Module Includes the Following Components:

Maternal Care Management Report

- Allows care team members to manage their entire panel of patients through each trimester, including postpartum.
- Includes pertinent information including delivery outcome, birth weight, screenings by trimester (including postpartum), SDOH triggers, and more.

PVP Alerts

- New alerts direct staff attention to outstanding actions like making postpartum appointments and conducting depression screenings.

Azara Patient Outreach (APO) Campaigns

- New prenatal and postpartum campaigns that conduct outreach for you, freeing up resources to focus on complex patients who need extra care coordination and management.

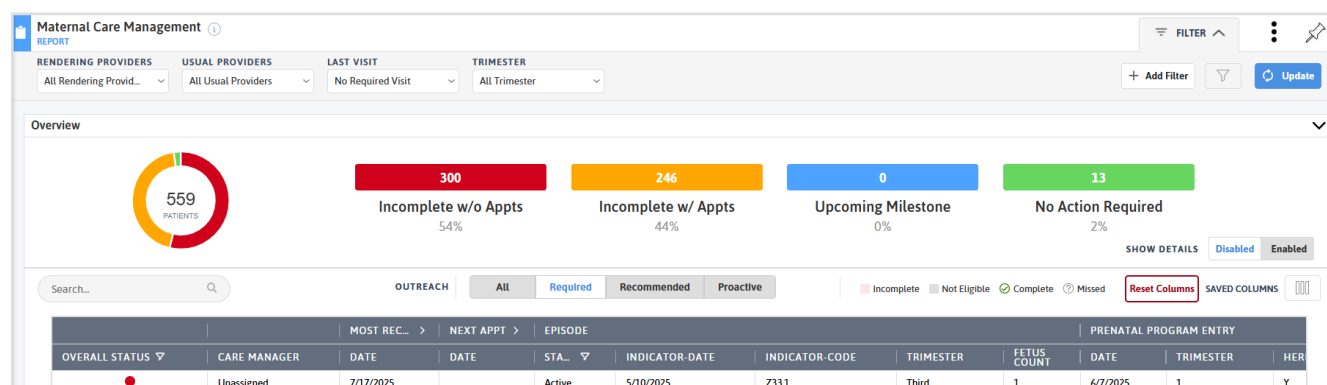
Summary Report

- Quickly get a list of currently pregnant patients including those at risk.
- Sort and filter by gestational age.
- Review key metrics, tests, and screenings.
- Differentiate between patients in and out of the formal prenatal program.
- Access a basic set of episode data (no labs or screenings).

UDS Reporting

- Episode-based reports are available for UDS Tables 6b and 7.
- Contains an “In CHC OB Care” filter to view only patients receiving prenatal care at your center.

Prenatal Passport

The Prenatal Passport provides a single patient report and snapshot of a patient's pregnancy or a complete episode of care – similar to the Azara DRVS Care Management Passport. The Prenatal Passport also provides a concise summary of a patient's pregnancy to support the care team.

- **Flowsheet:** All prenatal visits during the pregnancy, highlighting key vitals, procedures and screenings.
- **Screenings:** Checklist of required prenatal screenings (ACOG based).
- **Risk Factors:** Specific diagnoses and conditions that impact pregnancy and how prenatal care is provided.
