How Oak Valley Hospital Transformed

Quality Improvement with i2i Population Health

Overview

Oak Valley Hospital is a 150-bed facility in Oakdale, California, offering a broad network of services for a service area of 83,401. In addition to its hospital, Oak Valley has four clinics, including physical therapy, longterm care nursing and rehabilitation, and transitional care. Oak Valley Hospital has 500 employees.

Challenge

Oak Valley Hospital lacked the automated tools necessary to participate in many available quality programs. The hospital's first year with PRIME (a California-specific quality program that transitioned to QIP) was very difficult and required exhausting manual processes. Audits were "a nightmare."

They knew the potential financial impact quality programs could bring to the hospital, especially those focused on population health. In 2021, Oak Valley Hospital had an IT crisis that led to a communications outage that lasted several hours.





Solution

The hospital and clinics utilized i2i Messaging to text all patients and keep communications going, i2i Messaging within Tracks is fully integrated into patient searches, registries, quality reports, and UPM. "Individual texts to patients get a response nearly 100% of the time," said Lillie Avant, Population Health Coordinator at Oak Valley Hospital.

"Every step of the way, they (i2i) have been there. Any time I reach out, they review our stuff and make recommendations," said Avant. "There is no way we could have downloaded and aggregated all the EMR and health plan data, specific to who is enrolled and who had a visit. i2i makes it easy and powerful!"
